## Peach Bottom's First Confined Space Rescue Is Efficient, Safe

Yesterday Peach Bottom experienced its first ever Confined Space Rescue when carpenter working in the Torus overextended his shoulder and needed to be extricated from the area. The rescue was efficient and safe, and the injured individual was promptly transported to a local hospital, treated, and released back to work.
